Event History

Plan to participate in the 28th Annual Skokie Festival of Cultures, an award winning arts celebration of Skokie's cultural diversity! Over 25,000 people are expected to gather at Oakton Park, 4701 Oakton Street (Oakton Street & Skokie Boulevard) to enjoy delicious ethnic cuisine, arts and crafts from around the world, continuous performances and a wide variety of activities for children and adults. The Skokie Festival of Cultures is sponsored by the Skokie Park District, Village of Skokie Human Relations Commission, Skokie Rotary Club, Village of Skokie, Skokie Public Library, Skokie Chamber of Commerce, Skokie Fine Arts Commissions and Illinois Arts Council in cooperation with various community organizations.

Application Information

All completed applications must be received by, March 31, 2018. Selection decision notices and confirmations will be mailed by April 15, 2018. Receipt and processing of payment does not confirm acceptance in festival.

Eligibility

Skokie's Festival of Cultures will focus on the cultures represented within the wide ethnic diversity of Skokie, including but not limited to Asian, African-American, European, Filipino, Hispanic, Native American, Indian and Jewish. Exhibits, vendors and performers should further visitors understanding of a peoples way of living and may not promulgate specific religious or nationalist ideology.

Selection Criteria

The Skokie Festival of Cultures Committee will select applicants that best represent Skokie's cultural diversity. Decisions will be based on a completed application, entries that exemplify the traditional/ethnic arts, quality craftsmanship, ethnicity and prior participation in the Skokie Festival of Cultures event.

Applicants who wish to exhibit, display, sell or perform must submit a Skokie Festival of Cultures application form describing the items to be exhibited, displayed or sold and the country/culture represented. Performers must describe the performance and indicate which country/culture it represents. Photos of items to be displayed, exhibited or sold must be included with completed applications. The sale of food items is strictly prohibited. The Skokie Festival of Cultures Committee reserves the right to reject any application which in the Committee's opinion, conflict with the Skokie Park District and Village of Skokie ordinances or are considered inappropriate for this event.

The Skokie Park District, Village of Skokie, Skokie Public Library, Skokie Chamber of Commerce and Skokie Rotary Club will assume no responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged items belonging to Applicants.



Booth Space

Booth space is assigned by the Skokie Festival of Cultures Committee on a first-come, first-serve basis and are subject to the above stated conditions. Assignment of one (1) booth space per application fee is final. Exhibitors will be placed in a 10'x10' booth space within the Skokie tent. Vendors will be placed in an 10'x10' booth space within the Marketplace tent. One (1) table and two (2) chairs will be provided for each booth space. Vendors with their own free-standing tents and/or display structures will be placed outside of the Marketplace tent area in a 10'x10' area as space permits. No materials, extension cords, display boards or electricity are provided

Vendors are encouraged to make their displays as colorful as possible through the use of table covers, flags, decorations, etc. Vendors are also responsible for the cleanliness of their areas. Displays are to reflect the ethnic theme of the festival. Security will be provided on Saturday night. However, exhibitors and vendors are fully responsible for their items throughout the festival weekend.

Rates and Payment Information

application. Receipt and processing of payment does not confirm acceptance in festival. Refund of all monies paid will be made to any application not accepted. Selection decision notices and confirmations will be mailed by April 15, 2018.

General Rules and Regulations

Applications will not be reviewed or considered unless all required information is completed, fees are included and the application is signed.

Assignment of all booth spaces is final.

All fees submitted through the mail must be paid by check, money order, Visa, Mastercard or Discover. Check/money order should be made to the Skokie Festival of Cultures. No cash payments will be accepted through the mail.

The festival begins Saturday and Sunday at 11 a.m. Vendors/Exhibitors should arrive and check-in both days at the information booth at least one hour (10 a.m.) prior to the beginning of the festival. Vendors/Exhibitors are expected to stay until close of the festival (7 p.m.) both days of the event and will receive a \$50 refund of the application fee paid at the time of registration. In order to receive a \$50 refund, Vendors/Exhibitors are asked to check-out each evening of the festival at the information booth.

Driving or parking on the grass to set-up is strictly prohibited. Vendors/exhibitors are responsible for transporting their items into the event.

Only items listed on the submitted application may be displayed/sold at the festival.

Exhibitors/vendors are provided with one (1) table and two (2) chairs. There will be no additional tables/chairs available the days of the festival.

The Skokie Festival of Cultures Committee reserves the right to reject any exhibitor's/vendor's items which in the Committee's opinion conflict with the Skokie Park District and Village of Skokie ordinances and/or are considered inappropriate for this event.

The Skokie Park District, Village of Skokie, Skokie Public Library and Skokie Rotary Club assume no responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged items belonging to Skokie Festival of Culture participants.

Any exhibitor/vendor who is in violation of any of these stated rules and regulations may be asked to leave the festival grounds.

Parking

Exhibitors/vendors are not allowed to drive or park vehicles on the festival grounds. Driving and parking on the grass is strictly prohibited. All vehicles must be parked in a legal parking space. Upon acceptance of the completed application and receipt of a signed contract, exhibitors, vendors and performers will be given the locations of official parking sites in the vicinity of the festival.

Weather

As is the case with all outdoor events, inclement weather may occur. Please prepare for the possibility of such weather with the appropriate protective measures for yourself and the items that you have on display.
